Instructions

1. In the Introductory paragraph, replace the highlighted fields with the applicable information.
2. In paragraph 1, insert a termination date for the contract, or leave the first option in the clause, which provides that the contract will end when written notice is provided.
3. In paragraph 3, replace the highlighted fields with the applicable information regarding payment amounts and method of payment.
4. In paragraph 11, insert the state whose law will control in the highlighted fields.
5. In paragraph 13, remove if a non-compete provision is not needed.
6. In paragraph 14, insert the applicable contact information.
7. In the signature block, replace the highlighted fields with the signing party's information. The company name should be listed, if applicable. Otherwise, use the name of the individual.
8. In Exhibit A, outline the specific deliverables for the contract.



Terms of Use

Translation

Example #1: You are working with a company and you need to have them sign the agreement. In that situation, you may share the document. Example #2. Your friend asks you if you have a contract that she can use in a transaction you are not involved in. You are not permitted to share, but you can tell your friend how awesome our templates are and that she should purchase one for herself.
